Election Integrity

Resolution urging NHC GOP support the RNC Resolution “Return to Excellence” in American Voting and Elections.

Whereas, to require the NHC Election Integrity Team to report back to the County Executive Committee their findings and recommendations on the feasibility, roadblocks, projected cost, and recommendations on carrying out the objectives outlined in the RNC “Return to Excellence” Resolution ; therefore, be it

Resolved, that the New Hanover County Republican Party fully supports of the Republican National Committee’s “Return to Excellence” Resolution passed by unanimous vote of the governing committees.

RESOLUTION TO RETURN TO HAND-COUNTING OF PAPER BALLOTS

Whereas, North Carolina elections have become automated, lacking protection against electronic manipulation and cyber-attack, with voters having no ability to verify most machine-tabulated results, and software removing the voter from the observation of the tabulation process; and

Whereas, the NC State Board of Elections has not been audited since 2011 despite overwhelming demand from constituents for a hand-to-eye count audit; and

Whereas, machine-tallied results cannot be verified by voters with the exception of statistically insignificant non-representative samples; and

Whereas, the hand-counting of paper ballots is a time-tested, accurate method for which NC State Statutes already provide guidance; and

Whereas, the hand-counting of ballots has been demonstrated to produce accurate, timely election results, can be more cost effective and reliable than voting machines, and thus increase voter confidence in the results; therefore, be it

Resolved, that the constituents of New Hanover County urge the North Carolina State Legislature to provide for hand-counting procedures for all ballots in all elections in New Hanover County in order to bring the voter back into the counting process, increase engagement in elections, and increase voter confidence in the system.
